

## Book & Craft-to-Go! Spring Theme: Paper Bag Lamb Puppet

### Materials Included:

- (1) paper lunch bag,
- (2) papers with cutouts
- (1) instruction sheet

Materials you will need to provide: Crayons, or markers, scissors, glue or glue stick, optional-cotton balls.



Once you have the necessary materials you are ready to begin... Start by coloring the shapes of the paper cutouts (remember you are the artist so get creative if you'd like). Once colored cut them out, or have a grown up help with cutting them out. You will now follow the directions below, for placing them onto the bag to make your lamb puppet.

First off your paper lunch bag should be closed and flat like a piece of paper.

- The paper bag will be smooth on one side with no flaps. This will be the *BACK* of your puppet.
- On the other side there's a flip like flap (which is the bottom of the bag when it's opened up completely).
- This flip like flap will be the *HEAD* of the lamb.
  - You will glue the muzzle onto the *HEAD* on the flip like flap (place the muzzle just about half way over the fold of the flap, only put glue on the top half of muzzle that will be on the flip like flap.)
  - Lift the flip like flap up a bit.
  - Glue the mouth/tongue underneath the flip like flap so you can see part of the circle sticking out from under the muzzle. That way when you put your hand in the bag, you'll be able to make the puppet talk.
- Look at the rest of the front of the bag. (about 3/4 or so, of the bag below the flip like flap) glue the *BODY* of the lamb.
  - Look at the sides of the bag. There should be a *FOLD* of paper. Glue the arms into this fold. (No biggie if you glue the arm onto the front or back of the bag.)
  - Glue the eyes onto the *HEAD* above the muzzle.
  - Glue the ears onto the sides of the *HEAD*.
  - Glue the hair cut-out onto the top of the head.

Optional: Glue cotton balls if you would like to the hair cut out that you just glued down. Glue cotton balls onto the body cut-out that you glued down. Glue a cotton ball onto the *BACK* of the puppet as a tail.
