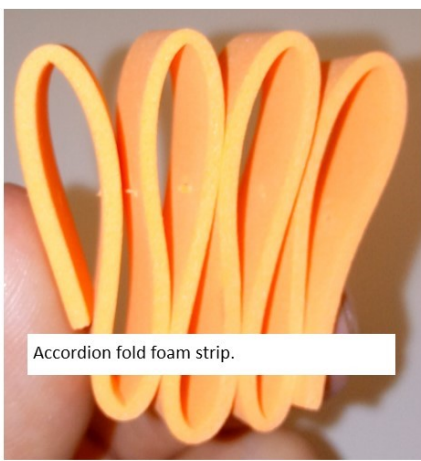


Book & Craft-to-Go! Spring Theme #2 Foamy Pipe Cleaner Caterpillar Craft



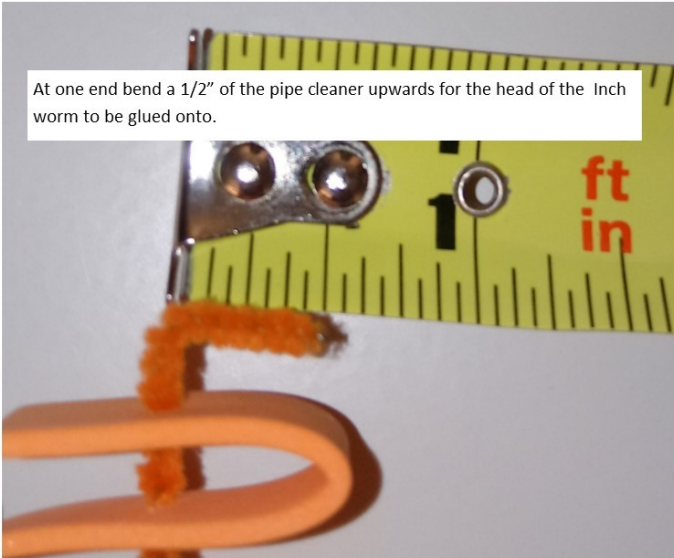
Accordion fold foam strip.



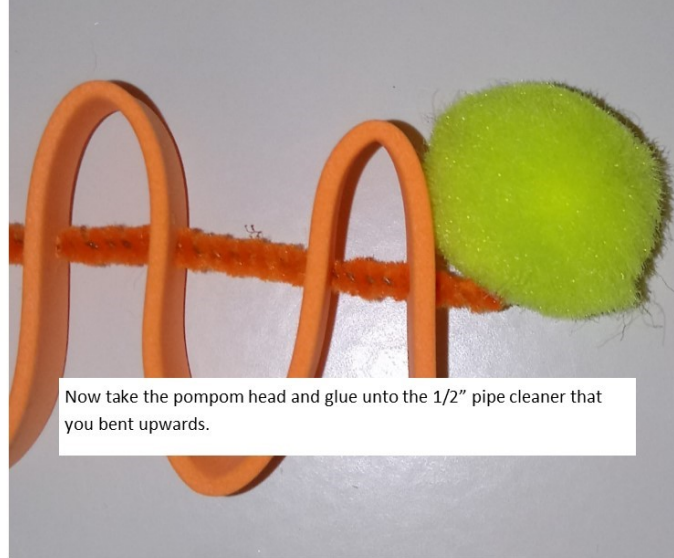
Take a small Phillip's screwdriver or nail and poke a hole through center of accordion folded foam strip.



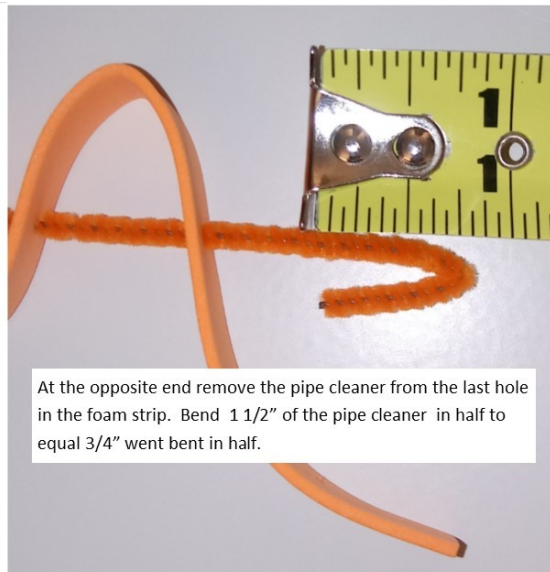
Push the pipe cleaner through the hole that you made .



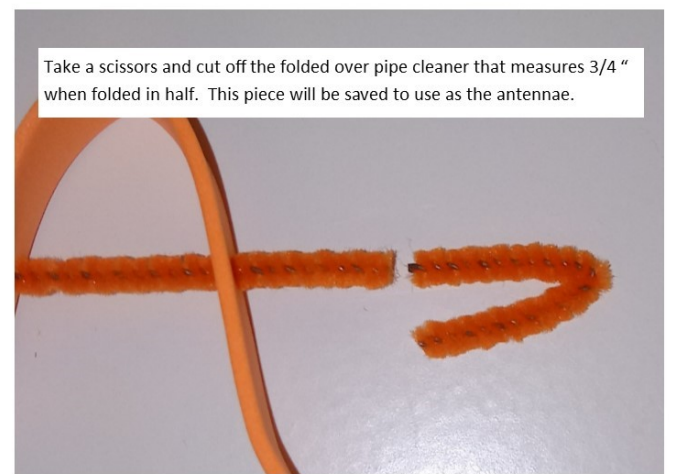
At one end bend a 1/2" of the pipe cleaner upwards for the head of the Inch worm to be glued onto.



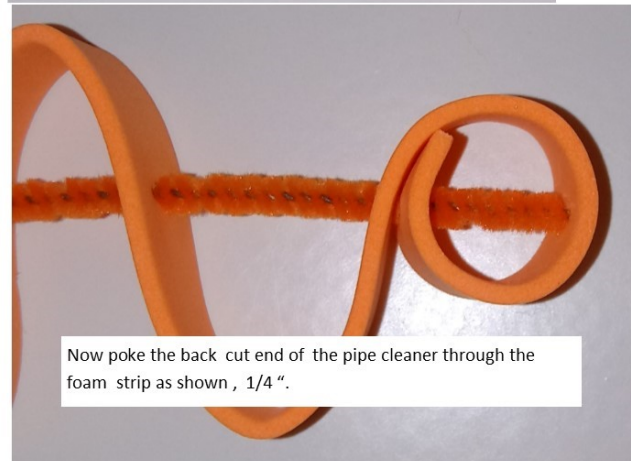
Now take the pom-pom head and glue unto the 1/2" pipe cleaner that you bent upwards.



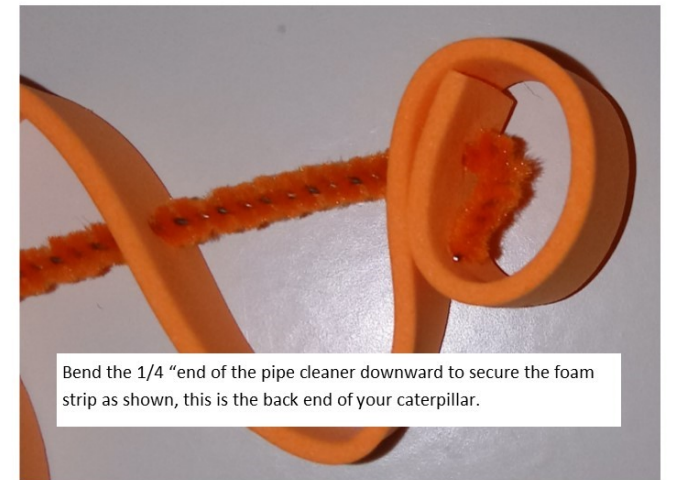
At the opposite end remove the pipe cleaner from the last hole in the foam strip. Bend 1 1/2" of the pipe cleaner in half to equal 3/4" bent in half.



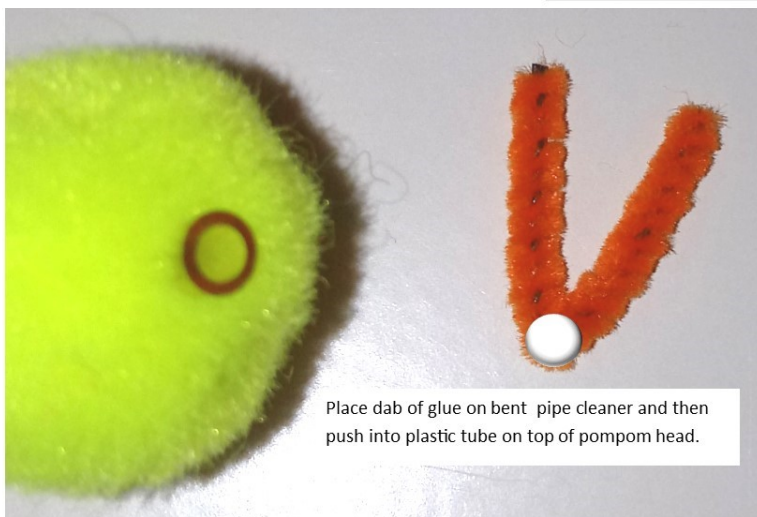
Take a scissors and cut off the folded over pipe cleaner that measures 3/4" when folded in half. This piece will be saved to use as the antennae.



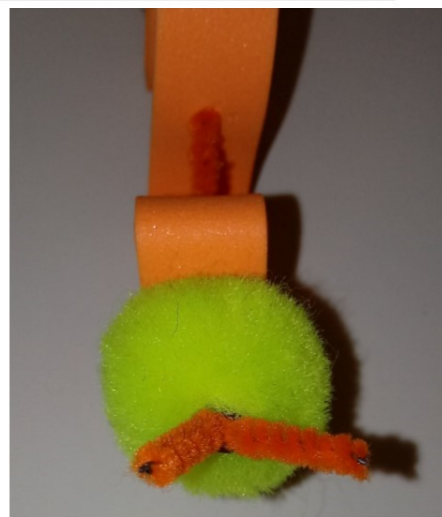
Now poke the back cut end of the pipe cleaner through the foam strip as shown , 1/4" .



Bend the 1/4 "end of the pipe cleaner downward to secure the foam strip as shown, this is the back end of your caterpillar.



Place dab of glue on bent pipe cleaner and then push into plastic tube on top of pom-pom head.



Then glue two googly eyes onto the front of the pom-pom head . Glue on and let dry .

Helpful Hint: You can scrunch and shape your Caterpillar to make him stand!
