

### The Woman in the Window


A.J. Finn



### [All We Knew But Couldn't Say](#)


Joanne Vannicola

Criticizes the way history is presented in current textbooks, and suggests a fresh and more accurate approach to teaching American history.



### The Hate U Give


Angie Thomas






## Coraline
