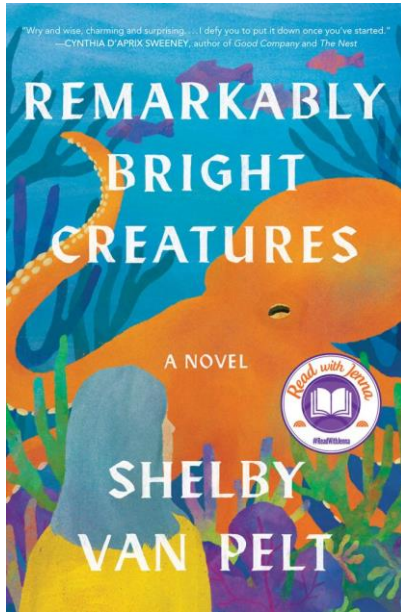

### Remarkably Bright Creatures

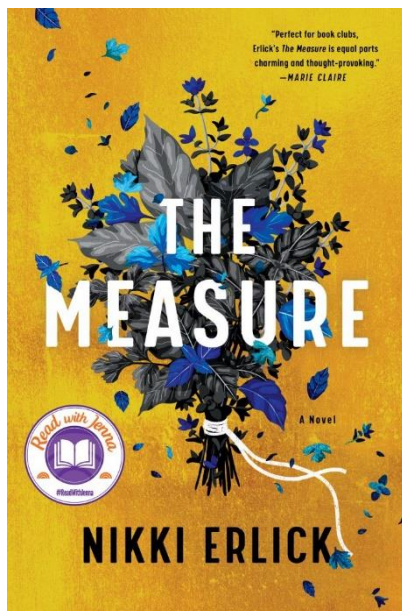
Shelby Van Pelt

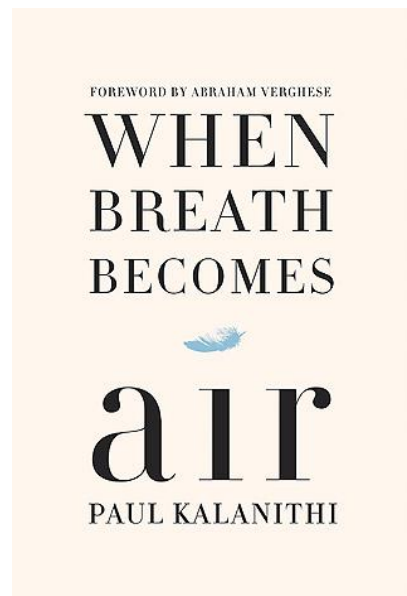

### When Breath Becomes Air

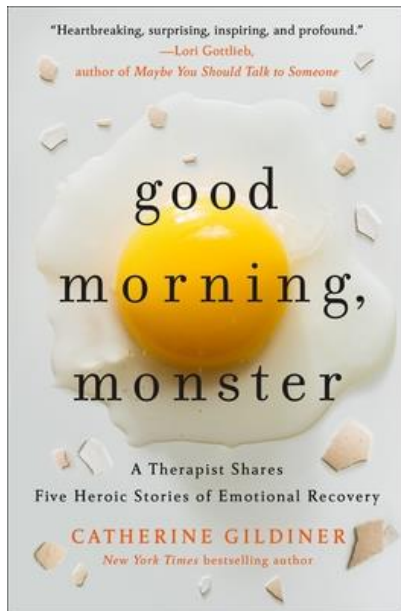
Paul Kalanithi

### Wild Is the Witch

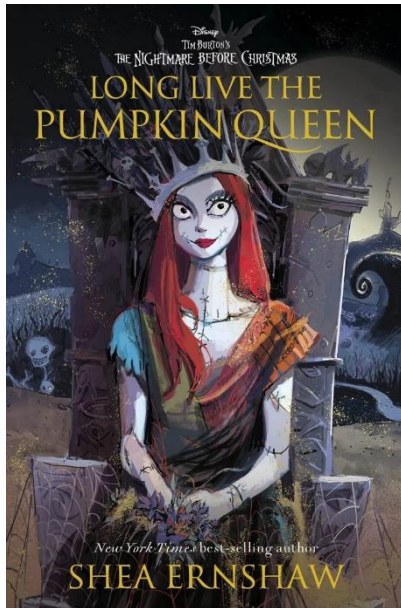
Rachel Griffin

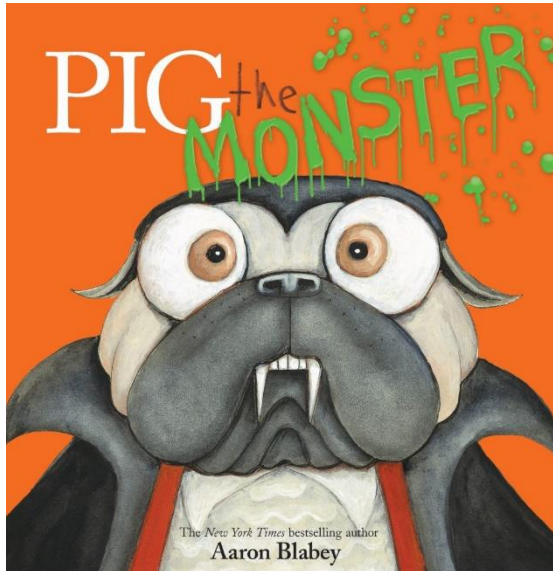

Aaron Blabey

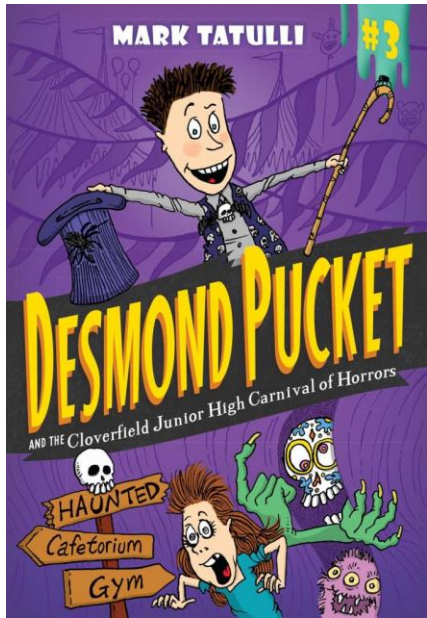
Pig is the world's greediest pug, and on Halloween he is completely out of control, thinking up nasty tricks to play on people who do not give him the treats he thinks he deserves.

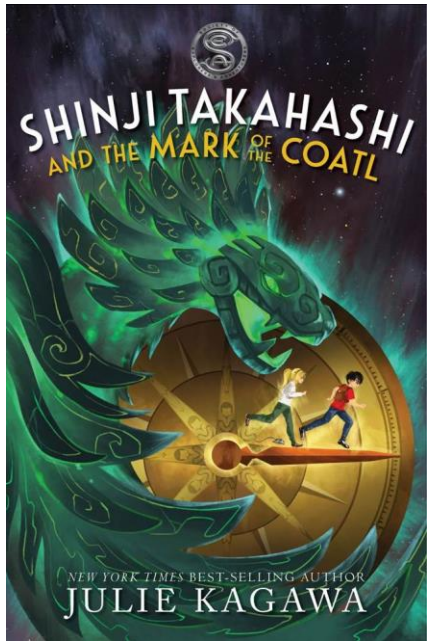
